The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India has conveyed approval for the establishment of an Integrated Aquapark at Kokernag, in UT of J&K under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY). Accordingly, in order to explore modalities for implementation of the Integrated Aquapark and to ensure expeditious compliance of requisite formalities as laid down in the approval, a Committee of the following Officers/ Officials headed by Sh. Shabir Ahmad Shabir, Assistant Director Fisheries (Nodal Officer) is hereby constituted.

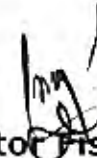

The Committee shall examine the approved proposal in light of the conditions laid down in the approval for establishment of the Integrated Aquapark at Kokernag-Dandipora cluster in District Anantnag. The Committee shall, inter alia, identify requirements for preparation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR), statutory clearances, and submission of documentary evidences regarding availability of requisite land with necessary permissions/ clearances from the concerned authorities of the UT. It shall conduct field visits to the identified sites and suggest a clear roadmap and way forward for timely and



effective execution of the project in conformity with the conditions stipulated in the approval. Besides, the committee shall coordinate with the Nodal Officer for all the necessary inputs, documentation, and facilitation in the matter. The designated committee in consultation with the nodal officer shall also suggest/ recommend changes, if any during the course of deliberations/ on-spot visits for effective implementation of the said Aquapark.

The committee shall submit a report along with its recommendations in a weeks' time to this Directorate, positively.
